



3. Limers Hill/Mill Street Common

1. Encourage woody regeneration on lowest slopes opposite development site and below Limers Hill, supplement with planting if necessary.
2. Cut bracken/bramble NE of recreation area in late July to encourage more diverse grassland to establish
3. Allow hedge at west end of recreation area to grow on and eventually be laid.
4. Reduce size of playing area around goal and increase mowing regime to 6-8 cuts per annum.
5. Plant W. edge of recreation area inside hedge and SW corner outside hedge with native feathered trees.
6. Manage remainder of area, with exception of paths, as meadow with autumn cut/clear.
7. Retain a turning head but preclude parking on paths by use of bollards

4. Barley Grove

1. Fell 3no. trees overhung or dominated by neighbours.
2. Undertake formative pruning on mature sycamore to balance crowns and give more space for new planting to north nearer car park.
3. Plant beech, lime and hornbeam as feathered trees to later replace sycamore, keeping clear of overhead line; under plant holly in 2-3 clumps within tree belt.
